1) Research Paper

- **Length between 10 to 12 pages**

2) Field Report

- Short articles on topics of interest to educational researchers and practitioners.
- **Length no less than 5 pages** and no specific form is required.

3) Best Practices

- Manuscripts that discuss innovative and successful programs or practices.
- Length no less than 5 pages

4) Book/Dissertation/Website/Social Media Reviews

- Reviews and critiques of books, doctoral dissertations, websites and social medias related to the above-mentioned topics.
- **Length no less than 3 pages** and no specific form is required.
